**Communication:** Weekly email – Newsletters – Make sure you are receiving these so we can reach you. Respond to emails. Check your spam/promotions. Weekly emails will always be on the website.

**CSEF:** Families who have moved from one school district to another in the past school year need to complete a new CSEF for each of your school-age students. If you have a student who has turned 6 years old this past school year, you need to complete a CSEF for that child (make sure you know in which school district you reside!).

**QuickBooks Online** is our school's accounting system. Lori Booth is our business manager. All families should receive an e-mail on the last day of each month as a reminder of monthly tuition due. There is a link in the e-mail to pay from your bank to Quickbooks. You can still pay by cash or check at meetings or in school office; or mail us a check; or have your bank send us a check. We do not accept credit card payments. If you believe there is a discrepancy on your account on the e-mail you receive, please contact the school office. If you did not receive the QuickBooks e-mail, please let us know that also, so we can correct it.

**You have made a tuition commitment for the school year 2024-25. Please pay by the 15<sup>th</sup> of each month. As stated in the handbook, failure to pay two months will result in probation, three months will result in possible disqualification from CRCS. If you have a financial crisis, please contact the administrator or member of the board.**

## **PARTICIPATION IN ACTIVITIES OFFERED ASSUMES TUITION IS CURRENT.**

**Community Church Child Protection Policy:** All volunteers (co-op, fine arts, clubs) will need to read and sign the policy as well as read the Child Abuse Prevention Training PDF and sign that they have read it. (Insurance requirement)

**Student Handbook: Dress, Grooming, and Behavior Code:** You and your students must read and abide by this code when involved in CRCS activities, including all field trips, co-op classes, dance classes, etc. Parents are the ones who should be enforcing this dress code.

**Drivers Permit/License:** If your student turns 15 or 16 and plans to take the driver's permit or driver's license test, the student must provide proof of school enrollment. Contact the school office for a ALEA form 1-93 enrollment/exclusion form. Or call and request that we mail it to you. These forms will also be available at the registration table.

**Office Hours** are Tuesdays and Thursdays, 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. ALEA forms for drivers permits and drivers licenses. Transcripts. Pay tuition.
