

SHELBY COUNTY COMMUNITY EDUCATION—SUMMER DRIVER EDUCATION  
For Public--Private—Home School Students

The Community Education Department of Shelby County Schools will offer Driver Education in the summer of 2025. This class is open to high-school students living in Alabama with valid driving permits. All classes are taught by certified teachers.

Driver Education consists of online classwork and behind-the-wheel instruction. Students will only meet for driving sessions. Students may complete classwork at their convenience but all classwork must be completed by the last day of class.

**Driver Education:** Before the start of class, students must have 50 miles of varied driving experience and be familiar with Google Classroom.

- Driving must be completed during the chosen session. Students will coordinate with the instructor on driving times. Students will not drive in inclement weather.
- Each student will receive a grade, semester credit, and Certificate of Completion.
- Upon passing the written work and driving portion, the student will receive instructions to obtain their Driver's License online.
