Online grade submission: Be ready with information before you start. Turn in grades on time. Print the PDF found in your submission email for your records. Downloadable/ printable lesson planner available on our website.

Our **directory** is compiled from our online registration. Notify the CRCS office by e-mail or phone of any future changes. If you did not receive an e-mail reminding you about this meeting, or receive an August newsletter, that means you are not on the master e-mail list, or we have an incorrect e-mail address. Search your promotions or junk folder. If you can not find the email, contact the office. When you graduate or leave- We will unsubscribe you from the email list at that point.

Communication: Weekly email OPEN AND READ – Newsletters – Make sure you are receiving these so we can reach you. Respond to emails. Check your spam/promotions. Weekly emails will always be on the website.

CSEF: Families who have moved from one school district to another in the past school year need to complete a new CSEF for each of your school-age students. If you have a student who has turned 6 years old this past school year, you need to complete a CSEF for that child (make sure you know in which school district you reside!).

QuickBooks Online is our school's accounting system. Lori Booth is our business manager. All families should receive an e-mail on the last day of each month as a reminder of monthly tuition due. There is a link in the e-mail to pay from your bank to QuickBooks. If that payment fails, you will be charged the \$10 fee the bank charges. You can still pay by cash or check at meetings or in school office; or mail us a check; or have your bank send us a check. We do not accept credit card payments. If you believe there is a discrepancy on your account on the e-mail you receive, please contact the school office. If you did not receive the QuickBooks e-mail, please let us know that also, so we can correct it. Please, if you find yourself getting behind in payments, due to oversight, contact your bank and set up automatic payments.

You have made a tuition commitment for the school year 2026-27. Please pay by the 15th of each month. As stated in the handbook, failure to pay two months will result in probation, three months will result in possible disqualification from CRCS. If you have a financial crisis, please contact the administrator or member of the board.
